The Study Zone

We have access to two well equipped activity rooms, a kitchen, toilets and an office. Twickenham Green is just across the road allowing us to play outdoor games and eat tea when the weather permits.

## Travel Information

### Parking

There is very limited parking outside the Study Zone and the car park is not available for parking between 8.00am - 6.15pm. If you have to travel by car you will find plenty of space along side the Green after 10 am and down Walpole and Vicarage Rd before 10.00 am. Please don't block the entrances to the car park as this can hinder the movements of our landlord and his employees at no 69.

### Cycling

We have two cycle racks; children are welcome to use them. However we cannot take any responsibility for bikes left there as they are in the Car Park next to the kitchen window of the Study Zone and so accessible by the public.

The Study Zone is conveniently situated for access by public transport.

### By London Transport Buses

Buses R70 (Richmond-Hampton), 281 (Hounslow-Tolworth), and 267 (Hammersmith-Fulwell) all stop directly outside The Study Zone on the Hampton Rd. Buses 290 (Richmond-Staines), 490 (Richmond-Hatton Cross), H22 (Richmond-Hounslow), stop on the opposite side of the Green a couple of minutes walk from the centre.

### Trains - Mains line services serve

**Strawberry Hill** (10 mins walk) with trains stopping every 15 mins on the Waterloo - Richmond - Twickenham - Kingston - Wimbledon loop.

**Twickenham** - (15 mins walk or short bus drive on 281 267 - see above) with trains every 15 mins on either the Waterloo - Richmond - Twickenham - Kingston - Wimbledon loop or on the Hounslow/Whitton line, with occasional services direct to Shepperton.

**Fulwell** (15 mins walk or short bus ride on 281, 267, or R70) with trains every 30 mins on the Waterloo - Shepperton Line.

### By Underground

The nearest station is Richmond (District Line) - all connecting Richmond Buses (see above) stop just outside Richmond Station.
